Quick Set Up Check List

Spa location has been identified ☐ Solid, flat and level foundation ☐ Clear path for delivery - no obstructions for height, width, bushes, trees, walkways
Locate and read the owner's manual Owner's manual is located in the bag inside the main spa body
Electrical requirements met Dedicated electrical with GFCI protection (see owner's manual) 120v spas are connected to a dedicated electrical outlet
Inspect the equipment (open equipment compartment) Make sure gate valves are open Drain cap is on and in closed position All visible plumbing unions are snug Replace equipment door
Filling your spa with water Remove the new filter cartridge and unwrap Soak your filter in water for approximately 30 minutes Fill spa with hose through the filter canister area of your spa Fill spa with water until about 6" from the top of the spa
Turning on the spa Turn on power at the GFCI Breaker Or plug in your spa to a dedicated electrical outlet for 120v spas Spa will go into self-diagnostic mode and begin priming To self-prime see owner's manual Replace the filter cartridge in your spa
Adjust water chemistry Adjust chemistry as described in your owner's manual Close the spa cover; when the spa is primed it will begin heating
